The Centre for Regional Trade (CRT), was established in April 2017. CRT has been established under The Centre for Research on International Trade (CRIT) which is a part of Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT), New Delhi under the Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. CRT is an autonomous Think-Tank mandated to focus on policy-oriented research while viewing India's economic engagements with the global economy through a regional lens. Broad areas of research, capacity building and outreach programmes cover Trade in Goods, Trade in Services, Investments, Technology and Developmental issues.

The Centre intends to engage researchers at the level of Research Fellow (Economics). The engagement shall be purely on contractual basis for a period of one year.

Qualifications

The candidate should possess the following qualifications:

- MA (Economics)/MA (International Trade) with sound knowledge of computer applications and packages [STATA, E-Views, R, SPSS etc.].
- The candidate should have good command over English (spoken as well as written) and should have interest in research.

Tenure

The appointment will be purely on contractual basis for a period of one year with a possibility of further extension based on the performance.

Emoluments:

The Research Fellow shall be paid fixed monthly emoluments of Rs. 36,000/- per month depending upon their qualification and experience.

Indian nationals having the above qualifications and experience should only apply and send their C.V. by email to headcrtoffice@crt.org.in latest by **31st May, 2019**.

The shortlisted candidates shall be called for written test, computer skill test and interview before the Selection Committee at the **Centre for Regional Trade (7th Floor), NAFED House, Siddhartha Enclave, Ashram Chowk, Ring Road, New Delhi - 110014**. The date and time of the test and interview shall be intimated to the shortlisted candidates only in due course. It is also brought to the notice of all concerned that no TA/DA shall be payable to the candidates appearing for the written test and interview and that the candidates coming from outside Delhi shall have to make their own arrangements for stay in Delhi and the CRT shall neither pay nor arrange for their accommodation.

Only the candidates selected finally will be informed and will need to join immediately. No other communication in this regard will be entertained.
